Call 911 if person is in immediate danger or if injured take them to the nearest emergency room

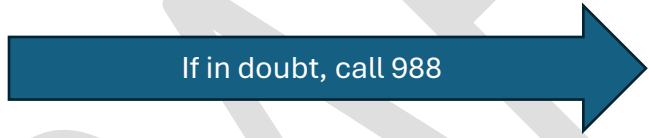
